- Lt. Katz is working with Steve Green to resolve water issues at station 82.
- Need to schedule a meeting for the station #81 remodel committee and come up with a design.
- Got all our SCBA bottles hydro tested as they were all out of date.
- Waiting for one more quote for the SCBA compressor wiring. Once I have that I will pick the electrical contractor to get that done.
- Will be setting up a meeting with the station remodel committee to start working on the design of station #81.
- I am going to start looking for some used water tenders to see what is out there.

COVID-19

- Firefighters have begun getting there COVID vaccine shots.

- GGFD provided coverage for TLFD so they could attend Cody & Shelby's funeral.
- After several revisions I was finally able to get the billing for Cameron Peak approved. So, should be seeing checks soon (I hope). The books will look a little off from last year as we had to pay our Firefighters in 2020.




